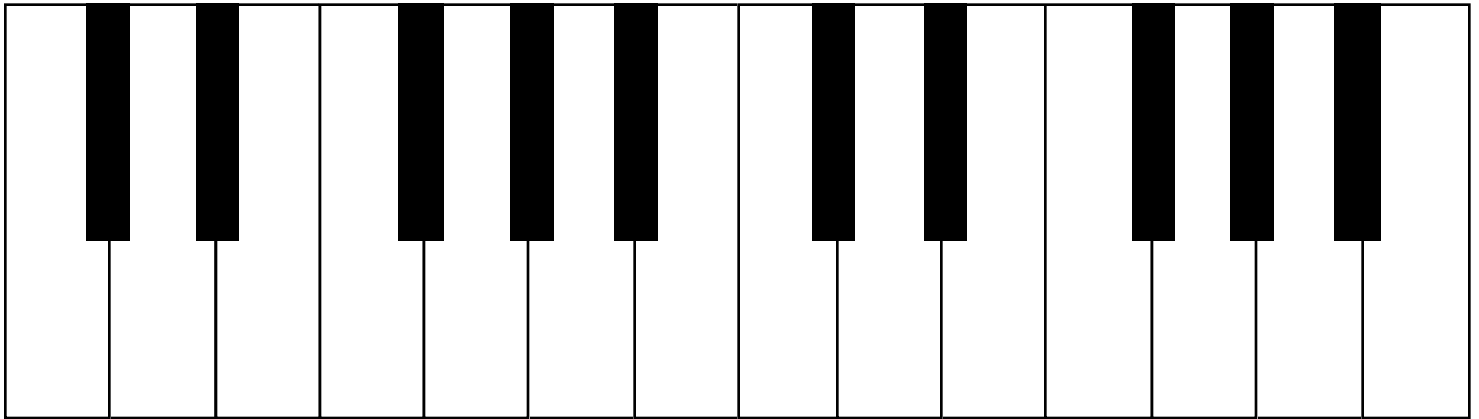


How to find the note C on a keyboard:

The black keys on a keyboard are arranged in groups of three, and pairs. To find any C on a keyboard, first locate a pair of black keys. C is the white key directly next to the first black in a pair of blacks. Remember the white keys on a keyboard are in musical alphabetic order. To find any note on the white keys of the keyboard first find C, then go up alphabetically until you get to the note you want to find. Try finding notes on the keyboard below.



C Position:

To play in C position, put your thumb on C, and your next four fingers go on the white keys right next to your thumb. G position is the same, but you put your thumb on G

Keyboard Test Songs

I have written them in with fingerings so you can play them in both C and G Position. Even if you don't have a keyboard, you can practice them by putting your right hand on a table and moving your fingers.
